

A note from our principal Ms. Nelson:

Dear Parents and Students,

Welcome to our fifth year at Rocky River High School! This past year, we have continued our tradition of strong academics, ensuring safety, security and order, as well as fostering strong student leadership. Our students' proficiency grew over 13% and our 9th grade Math students proficiency grew almost 20% in one year! Our graduation rate remains high at 88%. This year, we are focused around four priorities: increasing student academic success using data and providing feedback to teachers, increasing our positive and safe school culture, celebrating our staff, and expanding our community partnerships. We have created and will continue our partnerships with CBS Radio, New Beginnings Church, Chick-fil-A, the Latin American Women's Association, Men Who Care Global, the Young Black Male Leadership Alliance, the Mayor's Youth Empowerment Program, as well as other businesses and organizations. This will prove to be an exciting year at THE ROCK!!

Our school hours for 2014-2014 school year will be 7:10 a.m. to 2:10 p.m. Classes are approximately 90 minutes in length. We follow a hybrid schedule, which is a combination of block and A-day/B-day classes. We have worked diligently to prepare the class schedule that most closely fits your requests. Due to time conflicts and class overloads, it was not always possible to give students their first choice in every course; however, alternate choices were used if they were provided and space was available Schedule changes will be considered for the following reasons only: (1) a course needed for graduation, (2) a course for which a student has not met prerequisites, or (3) a course taken and passed in summer school. Students must attend all scheduled classes until a schedule change has been approved and they receive a new schedule.

As we continue the accomplishments we have garnered this past year, my pledge to you is that we will also continue to create a culture of excellence, leadership and pride throughout our school community. I look forward to seeing all Rocky River students on August 25th as we begin another great school year together!


